Week 5 Recap of Our Red Letter Sermon Series! : Old and New Testament! Jesus came to fulfill the law! Reflecting on Jesus' Teachings

We shared the first five minutes of Chosen Season 3, Episode 1, because when we read the Bible, especially the Red Letters, we should read it as though Jesus is speaking directly to us—because He is! The video of Him speaking on the hill while we sit and listen is incredibly powerful.



Remove all distractions and spend time with Him daily. This month, challenge yourself to read about Jesus more than you use your phone! Yes, if you use your phone to read about Jesus, that counts as engaging with His Word, but endless scrolling does not!

As you watch the video clip, envision Jesus saying these words to you. Picture yourself being present and listening to His teachings in the Sermon on the Mount.

### Understanding the Old Testament Law and Its Relevance Today:

Have you ever had difficulty understanding the Old Testament and the laws it contains? You are not alone! A helpful way to study the Old Testament is to read the New Testament. Whenever the Old Testament is mentioned, take the time to explore its context and meaning. A great example is during the Sermon on the Mount, where Jesus stated that He came to fulfill the law. This connection between the Old and New Testaments makes both relevant today! Here are several key points to consider:

**The Bible as God's Word:** The entire Bible is considered God's Word, which Christians are encouraged to study and appreciate.

**Understanding the New Testament:** To fully grasp the New Testament and the gospel, it is essential to understand the Old Testament, including the laws it presents.

**God's Character:** God's character, encompassing His holiness and love for justice, remains highly relevant in our lives today.

**In the New Testament:** Many teachings in the New Testament reinforce aspects of God's law for believers today. Notably, the New Testament emphasizes the two greatest commands that capture the essence of the law's purpose:

- 1. Love God: This represents the vertical relationship between God and His followers.
- 2. Love your neighbor: This represents the horizontal relationships among people.

Use this guide to deepen your understanding of Jesus' teachings and the relevance of the Old Testament law in our lives today.




